**AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND GOVERNING THE CONDUCT OF
SUBSTANTIATION HEARINGS IN CONNECTION WITH THE
REGISTRY OF REPORTS RELATIVE TO CHILD ABUSE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (a) of section 17a-101k of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to require the Commissioner of Children and Families to
- 3 adopt regulations in accordance with the provisions of chapter 54 of
- 4 the general statutes authorizing and governing the conduct of
- 5 substantiation hearings in connection with the registry of reports
- 6 relative to child abuse.

Statement of Purpose:

To specifically require the Commissioner of Children and Families to adopt regulations authorizing and governing the conduct of substantiation hearings in connection with the registry of reports relative to child abuse.
