AN ACT CONCERNING EDUCATION ON PROBLEMS ASSOCIATED WITH GAMBLING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (a) of section 10-16b of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to require that the program of instruction in public schools
- 3 shall include information concerning the prevention of problems
- 4 associated with gambling.

Statement of Purpose:

To attempt to prevent teenage gambling by including information on the problems of gambling in the health curriculum for school children.
