**Substitute Bill No. 5454**

*January Session, 2001*

**AN ACT TO ALLOW ELDERLY CITIZENS TO REMAIN IN ASSISTED LIVING FACILITIES AFTER THEY QUALIFY FOR TITLE XIX OR STATE ASSISTANCE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) The Commissioner of Social Services shall  
2 establish rates of reimbursement, based on the rate of reimbursement  
3 established under the Assisted Living Demonstration Program, as  
4 established in section 8-206e of the general statutes, for the  
5 reimbursement of managed residential communities, that elect to  
6 participate in such programs, for the provision of assisted living  
7 services to residents of such communities who meet the eligibility for  
8 Title XIX or state medical assistance.

9 Sec. 2. The sum of \_\_\_\_ dollars is appropriated, from the General  
10 Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002, to the Department of  
11 Public Health, for the purpose of reimbursing managed residential  
12 communities, that elect to participate in such program, for the  
13 provision of assisted living services to residents of such communities  
14 who meet the eligibility requirements for Title XIX or state medical  
15 assistance.

16 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001.
