AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE END CHILD POVERTY SOCIAL INVESTMENT FUND .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the End Child Poverty Social Investment Fund be established,
- 2 outside of the General Fund, to address the increasing rate of child
- 3 poverty in the state. It is further proposed that a two per cent marginal
- 4 tax be imposed on annual personal incomes in excess of two hundred
- 5 thousand dollars and that the revenue from such tax be deposited in
- 6 the End Child Poverty Social Investment Fund.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish the End Child Poverty Social Investment Fund, outside of the General Fund, to address the increasing rate of child poverty in this state.
