AN ACT CONCERNING A HIGHER REIMBURSEMENT RATE FOR CERTAIN SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 10-285a
2 of the general statutes, each local or regional board of education may
3 select one school building project in a twenty-year period for which the
4 percentage determined pursuant to section 10-285a of the general
5 statutes shall be increased in accordance with this section. (1) For a
6 project for which the reimbursement percentage is thirty-five per cent
7 or less, such percentage shall be increased by fifteen per cent; (2) for a
8 project for which the reimbursement percentage is greater than thirty-
9 five per cent but less than seventy per cent, such percentage shall be
10 increased by ten per cent; and (3) for a project for which the
11 reimbursement percentage is greater than seventy per cent, but less
12 than ninety-five per cent, such percentage shall be increased by five
13 per cent.

14 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow school districts to choose one project every twenty years for which they will receive reimbursement at a higher rate.
