**AN ACT CONCERNING FUNDING FOR THE RELOCATION AND EXPANSION OF THE AVIATION MAINTENANCE TECHNICAL TRAINING PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 ten million five hundred thousand dollars, the proceeds of which shall
- 5 be used by the Department of Education for the purpose of the
- 6 relocation and expansion of the aviation maintenance technical
- 7 training program from Ellis Vocational-Technical High School to
- 8 Brainard Airport.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To centrally locate and expand the existing post graduate aviation maintenance program to meet the needs of the rapidly expanding aviation job market in the state and surrounding areas.
