AN ACT CONCERNING INTERVENTION BY SIBLINGS IN COURT PROCEEDINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 46b-57 of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that the court may allow siblings of the minor child to intervene upon
- 3 motion and the court may award full or partial custody, care,
- 4 education or visitation rights of such child to any such sibling, upon
- 5 such conditions and limitations as the court deems equitable.

Statement of Purpose:

To give siblings standing in court proceedings.
