AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF ACCRUED SICK TIME FOR PAID FAMILY AND MEDICAL LEAVE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require any employer that
- 2 provides paid sick leave to its employees to allow its employees to
- 3 accrue any such unused sick leave and substitute such sick leave for
- 4 unpaid family and medical leave, when necessary.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow employees to accrue unused sick time which may be used for paid family and medical leave.
