AN ACT MODIFYING RATES FOR GROUP HOMES FOR ADOLESCENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. The sum of ____ dollars is appropriated to the
2 Department of Children and Families, from the General Fund, for the
3 fiscal year ending June 30, 2002, for the purpose of modifying the basis
4 on which the rates of private contracting for group homes for
5 adolescents are set and adjusting such rates accordingly.

6 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funds to change the current basis of rate setting for group homes for adolescents, which is currently inadequate and undermines the ability of private organizations to provide quality services to Connecticut's children and youth.
