Substitute Bill No. 6017

**AN ACT REQUIRING A COMPREHENSIVE STUDY OF RATE SETTING
AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR VARIOUS HEALTH CARE FACILITIES
AND AGENCIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. The Commissioner of Social Services, in conjunction with
2 the Commissioners of Mental Retardation, Mental Health and
3 Addiction Services and Public Health, shall study rate setting and
4 reimbursement for long-term care facilities, residential care homes,
5 home health care agencies, assisted living services agencies, group
6 homes or other residential facilities for mentally retarded persons and
7 community residences for mentally ill adults. Not later than July 1,
8 2002, said commissioners shall submit a report of their findings and
9 recommendations to the joint standing committees of the General
10 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to human services,
11 public health and appropriations and the budgets of state agencies and
12 to the select committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
13 matters relating to aging, in accordance with the provisions of section
14 11-4a of the general statutes.

15 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001.
