AN ACT CONCERNING RATE RELIEF FOR RESIDENTIAL CARE HOMES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That section 17b-340 of the general statutes be amended to: (1)
2 Allow for an increase in residential care home administrators' salaries
3 to a base of forty-six thousand dollars for homes with sixty beds or less
4 and fifty-four thousand two hundred twenty dollars for homes with
5 greater than sixty beds; (2) apply a new inflation factor to the cost
6 centers of dietary, housekeeping and laundry and to the per bed
7 increment; (3) remove wages from the caps on cost centers in
8 residential care homes; (4) increase the minimum fair rent to four
9 dollars per day; (5) apply change of ownership rate relief to include
10 related parties; (6) allow a one dollar per day add-on to the daily rate
11 for homes below the average rate which are comprised of ninety per
12 cent or more state assisted residents; and (7) increase from one
13 thousand dollars to five thousand dollars the depreciation cap based
14 on the federal Health Care Financing Administration's Medicare
15 revision.
