AN ACT CONCERNING A COMMUNITY COURT IN NEW HAVEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 51-81c of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Chief Court Administrator to expand the community court program to
- 3 New Haven in order to help New Haven deal more effectively with
- 4 community-oriented quality of life issues. A community court requires
- 5 offenders to compensate neighborhoods through community service,
- 6 and the punishment is combined with access to social service
- 7 programs, drug treatment, job training and educational opportunities.

Statement of Purpose:

To create a community court in New Haven.
