AN ACT CONCERNING REGISTRATION OF ELECTRIC GENERATORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 16-258b of the general statutes is repealed and the following
2 is substituted in lieu thereof:

3 Each person, as defined in section 16-1, operating an electric
4 generating facility in this state shall register with the Department of
5 Public Utility Control. Not later than January 1, 2001, the department
6 shall adopt regulations, in accordance with chapter 54, to establish
7 standards and procedures for the registration of electric generators
8 pursuant to this section. The provisions of this section shall not apply
9 to any (1) hydroelectric generating facility, or (2) electric generating
10 device (A) with a generating capacity of four megawatts or less, or (B)
11 that is owned and operated by an electric distribution company or gas
12 company, as defined in section 16-1. Each such person, upon
13 registering with the department, shall submit a certificate of liability
14 insurance coverage in an amount determined by the department.

Statement of Purpose:

To require that registrants of electric generators carry liability insurance.
