**AN ACT CONCERNING THE LOCATION OF REGISTRATION  
STICKERS ON MOTOR VEHICLES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 246 of the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 upon registration and renewal of registration of a motor vehicle, the
- 3 Department of Motor Vehicles shall issue two reflective stickers with
- 4 the year that renewal runs out stamped on it, one of which shall be
- 5 placed on the inside of the windshield on the bottom left hand side
- 6 above the emissions sticker, and the other of which shall be placed on
- 7 the bottom left side of the back window.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To eliminate the placement of registration stickers on license plates as a way of eliminating the theft of license plates for the stickers.
