**AN ACT CONCERNING A MUNICIPAL PILOT PROGRAM FOR SEPTIC AND WASTEWATER SYSTEMS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 16 of the general statutes be amended to allow
- 2 municipalities to apply to the Department of Environmental Protection
- 3 for pilot program status for projects involving the development and
- 4 implementation of a septic and wastewater system for school and
- 5 municipal use that would have independent channels for the disposal
- 6 of gray water and septic effluent.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To permit municipalities to apply for pilot program status for projects involving development of septic systems with independent channels for the disposal of gray water and septic effluent.
