**AN ACT CONCERNING A SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE HONORING
STATE TROOPERS AND MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICERS KILLED IN
THE LINE OF DUTY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 (NEW) The Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, at the request of any
2 person, shall issue a special certificate of registration and a set of
3 number plates memorializing state and municipal police officers who
4 are killed in the line of duty. Said registration and number plates shall
5 be available for any motor vehicle (1) owned or (2) leased for a period
6 of at least one year. Said number plates shall expire and be renewed as
7 provided in section 14-22 of the general statutes. The commissioner
8 shall charge a fee for such plates which shall cover the entire cost of
9 making the same and which shall be in addition to the fee for
10 registration of such motor vehicle.

Statement of Purpose:

To create a special license plate honoring state and municipal troopers killed in the line of duty.
