**Substitute Bill No. 6522**

*January Session, 2001*

**AN ACT CONCERNING A SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE HONORING  
STATE TROOPERS AND MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICERS KILLED IN  
THE LINE OF DUTY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 (NEW) The Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, at the request of any  
2 person, shall issue a special certificate of registration and a set of  
3 number plates memorializing state and municipal police officers who  
4 are killed in the line of duty. Said registration and number plates shall  
5 be available for any motor vehicle (1) owned, or (2) leased for a period  
6 of at least one year. Said number plates shall expire and be renewed as  
7 provided in section 14-22 of the general statutes. The commissioner  
8 shall charge a fee for such plates which shall cover the entire cost of  
9 making the same and which shall be in addition to the fee for  
10 registration of such motor vehicle. The design of such plates shall be  
11 approved by a committee established by the commissioner. The  
12 committee shall include a representative of the Concerns of Police  
13 Survivors, Inc., the Connecticut State Police Union and the Connecticut  
14 Council of Police. The first one thousand plates shall be reserved for  
15 widows, parents or children of state troopers killed in the line of duty.
