***AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A STATUE OF PRUDENCE CRANDALL
FOR THE STATE CAPITOL BUILDING.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (a) There is established a Prudence Crandall Statue
2 Committee. The committee shall recommend to the Joint Committee
3 on Legislative Management (1) an artist to sculpt a statue of Prudence
4 Crandall, the state heroine, for the State Capitol Building, and (2) a
5 location in the building for the placement of the statue. The committee
6 shall invite artists to submit designs for the statue and shall review the
7 designs and select an artist. The committee may accept, on behalf of
8 said joint committee, private donations for the statue. Not later than
9 February 1, 2002, the committee shall submit its recommendations to
10 said joint committee.

11 (b) The committee shall consist of one member each appointed by
12 the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the speaker of the House of
13 Representatives, the president pro tempore of the Senate, the majority
14 leader of the House of Representatives, the majority leader of the
15 Senate, the minority leader of the House of Representatives and the
16 minority leader of the Senate.

17 Sec. 2. The sum of one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars is
18 appropriated to the Joint Committee on Legislative Management for
19 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002, for the statue of Prudence
20 Crandall.

21 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001.
