***AN ACT CONCERNING TEMPORARY HELP SERVICES.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to: 1) Require each temporary  
2 help service, as defined in subsection (e) of section 31-129 of the  
3 general statutes, to A) compensate each individual employed by such  
4 temporary help service at a rate not less than the rate currently being  
5 paid to permanent employees of the employer to whom such  
6 individual has been assigned to provide temporary help, and B)  
7 provide health insurance coverage to each individual employed by  
8 such temporary help service; and 2) prohibit any temporary help  
9 service from charging an employer a fee as a result of the employer's  
10 decision to directly hire an individual furnished to the employer on a  
11 temporary basis by the temporary help service.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To ensure that employees of temporary help services receive adequate compensation and benefits.
