***AN ACT AUTHORIZING RETIRED HOSPITAL EMPLOYEES TO
OBTAIN DRUGS AT HOSPITALS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 20-610 of the general statutes is repealed and the following
2 is substituted in lieu thereof:

3 (a) No legend drug, legend device or drugs listed in subsection (b)
4 of this section may be dispensed or sold at retail except in a pharmacy
5 or by a hospital licensed under sections 19a-490 to 19a-503, inclusive,
6 to an employee of the hospital when prescribed by a prescribing
7 practitioner for the employee or the employee's spouse or dependent
8 children.

9 (b) The following drugs may not be sold at retail except as
10 permitted in subsection (a) of this section: (1) Injectable or ingestible
11 antibiotics; (2) injectable biologicals; (3) sulfonamides and their
12 compounds which are designed to be taken into the stomach for
13 systemic action; (4) injectable or ingestible corticosteroids; or (5)
14 camphorated tincture of opium.

15 (c) Any person who violates any provision of this section shall be
16 fined not less than one hundred dollars nor more than five hundred
17 dollars.

18 (d) Subsection (a) of this section shall not apply to any retired
19 employee of a hospital, if such retired employee is not the spouse of an
20 employee of a hospital who is not retired.

Statement of Purpose:

To authorize retired employees of hospitals to obtain drugs at hospitals.
