AN ACT CONCERNING A TELECOMMUNICATIONS OVERCHARGE PENALTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 (NEW) Any person who provides telecommunications services, as
- 2 defined in section 16-49 of the general statutes, and charges a customer
- 3 more than the customer owes under the customer's contractual
- 4 agreement with the person providing the telecommunications services,
- 5 shall reimburse the customer two hundred per cent of the amount
- 6 overcharged.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce telecommunications providers' abuse of consumers.
