***AN ACT CONCERNING A PILOT PROGRAM TO CONSOLIDATE  
PUBLIC SAFETY ANSWERING POINTS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall establish a pilot  
2 program in the area of operation of the capitol region planning region  
3 to consolidate public safety answering points. The program shall be  
4 administered by the Capitol Region Council of Governments.

5 Sec. 2. Subsection (c) of section 28-30a of the general statutes is  
6 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

7 (c) The resources of the Enhanced 9-1-1 Telecommunications Fund  
8 shall be used solely to fund the expenses, as determined by the  
9 Commissioner of Public Safety in accordance with subsection (c) of  
10 section 28-24, associated with the enhanced emergency 9-1-1 program  
11 and to provide funds for the pilot program established pursuant to  
12 section 1 of this act. Any surplus shall be carried forward to successive  
13 fiscal years and used for the sole purpose of administering the  
14 enhanced emergency 9-1-1 program.

15 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To establish a pilot program, administered by the Capitol Region Council of Governments, to consolidate public safety answering points in areas where police, fire, and medical services are dispatched, thereby improving efficiency in the provision of emergency services.
