**AN ACT ESTABLISHING REMEDIES TO ADJUDICATE DISPUTED
SECOND INJURY FUND ASSESSMENTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) The State Treasurer may request the Attorney
2 General to bring an action in the Superior Court against any employer
3 or any private insurance carrier or interlocal risk management agency
4 acting on behalf of an employer that fails to comply with the Second
5 Injury Fund reporting requirements set forth in section 31-354 of the
6 general statutes for injunctive relief requiring compliance with such
7 reporting requirements.

8 Sec. 2. (NEW) Any employer or any private insurance carrier or
9 interlocal risk management agency acting on behalf of an employer
10 that is aggrieved by a decision of the State Treasurer or the State
11 Treasurer's agents concerning the method of assessing the employer
12 for the liabilities of the Second Injury Fund pursuant to section 31-349g
13 of the general statutes may appeal the decision to the Superior Court in
14 accordance with the provisions of section 4-183 of the general statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide a process by which the State Treasurer, employers and insurance companies may resolve disputes about assessments for liabilities of the Second Injury Fund.
