**AN ACT REQUIRING REGIONAL WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT
BOARDS TO SUBMIT ANNUAL PERFORMANCE MEASURES TO THE
OFFICE OF WORKFORCE COMPETITIVENESS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 Section 31-3k of the general statutes is amended by adding
2 subsection (d) as follows:

3 (NEW) (d) On October 1, 2002, and annually thereafter, each board
4 shall submit to the Office of Workforce Competitiveness
5 comprehensive performance measures detailing the success of any
6 education, employment or job training program or activity funded by
7 moneys allocated to the board, including, but not limited to, programs
8 and activities specified in the federal Workforce Investment Act of
9 1998, P.L. 105-220, as from time to time amended. Such performance
10 measures shall include the identity and performance of any vendor
11 that enters into a contract with the board to conduct, manage or assist
12 with such programs or activities, the costs associated with such
13 programs or activities, the number, gender and race of persons served
14 by such programs or activities, the number, gender and race of persons

15 completing such programs or activities, occupational skill types, the
16 number, gender and race of persons who enter unsubsidized
17 employment upon completion of such programs or activities, the
18 number, gender and race of persons who remain in unsubsidized
19 employment six months later and the earnings received by such
20 persons.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the regional workforce development boards to provide the Office of Workforce Competitiveness with comprehensive performance measures for all education, employment and job training programs funded by the boards.
