



AN ACT CONCERNING ONE-STOP CENTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 (NEW) (a) In addition to the required partners identified in section
2 121(b)(1) of the federal Workforce Investment Act of 1998, P.L. 105-220,
3 as from time to time amended, and subject to the approval of the
4 regional workforce development board and the chief elected official for
5 the local area, each one-stop center shall include a local community
6 action agency, as defined in section 17b-885 of the general statutes, and
7 an opportunities industrialization center as one-stop partners and shall
8 provide eligible individuals utilizing the one-stop center with access to
9 programs and activities carried out by such community action agency
10 and opportunities industrialization center.

11 (b) At least one representative from the Department of Social
12 Services shall be available on-site at each one-stop center to provide
13 eligible individuals utilizing the one-stop center with information or
14 assistance concerning any service or program administered by the
15 department.

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
