AN ACT PROHIBITING PERSONS UNDER SIXTEEN YEARS OF AGE FROM USE OF ARTIFICIAL TANNING MACHINES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 (NEW) No person shall permit any individual under sixteen years
- 2 of age use of any artificial tanning machine. For the purpose of this
- 3 section, "artificial tanning machine" means any device marketed or
- 4 designed to tan the human skin through use of an artificial source of
- 5 ultraviolet light. A violation of this section shall be an infraction.

Statement of Purpose:

To limit the use of artificial tanning machines to persons sixteen years of age or older.
