**AN ACT PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE TRANSPORTATION NEEDS
OF ELDERLY AND DISABLED PERSONS AND PERSONS
TRANSITIONING FROM WELFARE TO WORK.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (a) The sum of five million eight hundred thousand
2 dollars is appropriated to the Department of Transportation, from the
3 Special Transportation Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002,
4 for the Dial-A-Ride program.

5 (b) The sum of three million five hundred thousand dollars is
6 appropriated to the Department of Social Services, from the General
7 Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002, for the Transportation
8 for Employment Independence Program.

9 (c) The sum of seven million nine hundred thousand dollars is
10 appropriated to the Department of Social Services, from the General
11 Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002, for Aid to the Disabled.

12 (d) The appropriation to the Department of Transportation, from the
13 Special Transportation Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002,
14 shall be increased by the sum of eight million six hundred thousand

15 dollars for state-wide bus operations.

16 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funds to meet the transportation needs of elderly persons, disabled persons and persons transitioning from welfare to work.
