AN ACT CONCERNING FOSTER PARENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Subsection (o) of section 46b-129 of the general statutes is repealed
2 and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

3 (o) A foster parent shall have [standing] the right to be heard for the
4 purposes of this section in Superior Court in matters concerning the
5 placement or revocation of commitment of a foster child living with
6 such parent. A foster parent shall receive notice of any motion to
7 revoke commitment or any hearing on such motion. A foster parent
8 who has cared for a child or youth for not less than six months shall
9 have [standing to] the right to be heard and comment on the best
10 interests of such child or youth in any matter under this section which
11 is brought not more than one year after the last day the foster parent
12 provided such care.
