**AN ACT CONCERNING ELIGIBILITY FOR A NORMAL RETIREMENT
BENEFIT UNDER THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 Subsection (a) of section 10-183f of the general statutes is repealed
2 and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

3 (a) A member is eligible to receive a normal retirement benefit who
4 (1) has attained age sixty and has accumulated twenty years of
5 credited service in the public schools of Connecticut, or (2) has attained
6 any age, has accumulated at least twenty-five years of credited service
7 in the public schools of Connecticut, and has accumulated (A) as of
8 June 30, 2003, thirty-five years of credited service, [at least twenty-five
9 years of which are service in the public schools of Connecticut] (B) as
10 of July 1, 2003, to June 30, 2004, inclusive, thirty-four years of credited
11 service, or (C) on and after July 1, 2004, thirty-three years of credited
12 service.

Statement of Legislative Commissioners:

The phrase "at least twenty-five years of" credited "service in the public
schools of Connecticut" was moved for clarity.
