**RESOLUTION CONVENING THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN SPECIAL
SESSION.**

Resolved by this Assembly:

1 That Pursuant to Article III of the amendments to the state
2 constitution, and Rule 33 of the Joint Rules of this session, we the
3 members of this General Assembly judge it necessary that there be a
4 special session of the General Assembly, that said session be convened
5 not earlier than 12:01 a.m. on November 15, 2001, and that the call of
6 the session be solely for the purposes of considering and enacting the
7 following bills:

8 (1) To modify appropriations authorized in Special Act 01-1 of the
9 June special session;

10 (2) To increase bond authorizations, to the extent required, by any
11 reduction made during such special session in appropriations made

12 for debt avoidance in subsection (a) of section 47 of Special Act 01-1 of
13 the June special session;

14 (3) To defer the incremental elimination of the succession and
15 transfer tax; and

16 (4) To increase penalties for hoaxes by amending sections 53a-180,
17 53a-180a, 53a-180b, 53a-181, and 53a-62 of the general statutes, and by
18 adding the following as criminal offenses: Falsely reporting an incident
19 in the second degree, breach of the peace in the first degree, and
20 threatening in the first degree.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the clerks of the Senate and the
22 House of Representatives deliver a copy of this resolution to the
23 Secretary of the State forthwith.
