**RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SYMPATHY ON THE DEATH OF  
FORMER STATE REPRESENTATIVE JAMES SINCLAIR CONNERY,  
SR.**

Resolved by this House:

1 WHEREAS, James Sinclair Connery, Sr., a longtime resident of the  
2 city of Shelton, died on January 1, 2001; and

3 WHEREAS, James Connery served for three terms from 1969  
4 through 1974 as State Representative from the city of Shelton; and

5 WHEREAS, James Connery honorably served his country during  
6 World War II as a tech sergeant in the Army Air Corps; and

7 WHEREAS, James Connery served his fellow citizens as President  
8 of the Shelton-Derby Lions Club, Chairman of the American Cancer  
9 Society Drive in Shelton, and Chairman of the Shelton Republican  
10 Town Committee from 1964 to 1971; and

11 WHEREAS, James Connery is survived by his wife, Betty Jean; his  
12 sons, James S. Connery, Jr. of Shelton, and Ronald A. Connery of  
13 Derby and their respective spouses, Barbara and Donna; his daughter,  
14 Cynthia Joy Garafolo of Beacon Falls and her spouse, Peter; and six  
15 grandchildren and one great-granddaughter.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Connecticut  
17 General Assembly expresses its deep sympathy and sincere  
18 condolences to the family of James Sinclair Connery, Sr. and to his  
19 neighbors and friends on his passing; and
