AN ACT CONCERNING THE ACQUISITION OF DATA RIGHTS TO THE AERIAL SURVEY OF THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. The sum of one million nine hundred thousand dollars is
2 appropriated from the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30,
3 2001, to the Department of Environmental Protection for the
4 acquisition of the data rights to and products of the aerial survey of the
5 state's land area.

6 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect from its passage.

Statement of Purpose:

To insure that data rights and products of the state's aerial survey will be available to towns without significant cost to them.
