**AN ACT CONCERNING CERTAIN SURVEYS CONDUCTED BY
SCHOOL DISTRICTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 170 of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 school districts to obtain written informed consent from the parents or
- 3 legal guardians of students before administering any student academic
- 4 or nonacademic survey, assessment or evaluation, or requiring
- 5 participation in any comprehensive guidance and counseling values
- 6 clarification program.

Statement of Purpose:

To require school districts to obtain written parental consent before students fill out any survey, analysis, or evaluation that deals with information concerning sensitive issues. To ensure that parents consent to surveys dealing with student behavior and attitudes.
