AN ACT CONCERNING VIDEO GAMES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 (NEW) (a) No owner of a video game arcade or any video games in
2 such other facilities, including, but not limited to, fairs, movie theaters,
3 shopping malls, hotels, schools and carnivals, shall permit a person
4 under the age of eighteen to operate a point and shoot video simulator.
5 A point and shoot video simulator is a device that involves one or two
6 individuals firing simulated hand guns at a video screen which depicts
7 human silhouettes, life-like representations of human beings and
8 civilian transportation services, including, but not limited to,
9 representations of cars, buses, trains, aircraft and commercial and
10 residential structures.

11 (b) Violation of this section shall be an infraction.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit a person under the age of eighteen from operating point and shoot video games.
