AN ACT CONCERNING CHLAMYDIA TESTING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require that all colleges and
- 2 universities in Connecticut test incoming freshmen for chlamydia and
- 3 to require that all secondary school students in Connecticut be tested
- 4 for chlamydia prior to entering the twelfth grade.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce the number of cases of chlamydia in secondary schools, colleges and universities.
