AN ACT CONCERNING BENEFITS FOR CERTAIN MUNICIPAL CHIEF ELECTED OFFICIALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That not sooner than four years after leaving state office or
2 employment, whichever is later, any person vested in the state
3 employees retirement system who has completed not less than six
4 consecutive years of service as a member of the General Assembly may
5 purchase credit, if a member of Tier I or Tier IIA, or receive credit if a
6 member of Tier II, for each year of service as a paid municipal chief
7 elected official.

Statement of Purpose:

To recognize the service of state legislators who previously served as paid municipal chief elected officials.
