**AN ACT CONCERNING INSURANCE FOR COMPETITIVELY BID
GOVERNMENT PROJECTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) prohibit a state or
2 municipal agency, employee or designee from requiring a person to
3 obtain insurance or other surety from a specified company, agent,
4 broker or producer, if the insurance or surety concerns a competitively
5 bid public building or construction contract and (2) make any person
6 who violates a provision of this section guilty of a misdemeanor and
7 subject to a fine of not more than five thousand dollars or
8 imprisonment for a term not greater than five years, or both.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow persons who bid on a public building or construction contract to obtain required insurance from any licensed insurance company or agent.
