**AN ACT CONCERNING INATTENTIVE DRIVING.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 248 of the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 any person who operates a motor vehicle shall give such person's full
- 3 time and attention to such operation and shall maintain a proper
- 4 outlook during such operation, and the failure to do so shall constitute
- 5 the offense of inattentive driving.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To increase safety on the roadways by establishing the offense of inattentive driving and sanctioning drivers who fail to pay proper attention to the roadway while driving.
