**AN ACT CONCERNING EMPLOYER RETENTION OF EMPLOYEE
MEDICAL RECORDS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 31-128c of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 employers to retain medical records pertaining to an employee for a
- 3 minimum of three years following termination of employment.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that employees are able to inspect and copy medical records maintained by their employers for at least three years following termination of employment.
