**AN ACT CONCERNING A BOND AUTHORIZATION FOR EXPANSION
OF THE NEW BRITAIN MUSEUM OF AMERICAN ART.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 seven million dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the
- 5 Department of Economic and Community Development for the
- 6 purpose of a grant to the New Britain Museum of American Art for its
- 7 expansion.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide a grant for a portion of the cost of the expansion.
