Substitute Bill No. 442

AN ACT CONCERNING THE AVAILABILITY OF HEALTH INSURANCE THROUGH THE HUSKY PLAN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 (NEW) Each employer that does not offer to its employees a health
2 insurance plan, as defined in section 38a-476 of the general statutes,
3 shall, upon offering employment to a prospective employee, inform
4 the prospective employee of the availability of health insurance for
5 certain eligible children under the HUSKY plan pursuant to chapter
6 319v of the general statutes. Such information also shall be made
7 available to employees hired prior to October 1, 2001, who have not
8 been informed of such availability. The employer shall include in each
9 employee's personnel file a notation, signed by the employee, of the
10 fact that such information has been provided.
