**AN ACT CONCERNING NORWICH REGIONAL VOCATIONAL-  
TECHNICAL SCHOOL.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That upon consolidation of the Three Rivers Community-Technical  
2 College, the vacated property at 574 New London Turnpike be  
3 occupied within ninety days by the Norwich Regional Vocational-  
4 Technical School. It is proposed that the administrative, academic and  
5 trade shop functions be moved but not those shops requiring  
6 construction of conjoined modern facilities at the south side of the  
7 existing structure, especially the automotive garage, machine shops,  
8 machine, carpentry, plumbing and electrical shops. It is proposed that  
9 the entire conjoined property be administered by the Regional  
10 Vocational-Technical School System under the Department of  
11 Education for expansion of services to the surrounding nineteen  
12 communities.

To provide for the expansion and relocation of Norwich Regional Vocational Technical School.
