**AN ACT REQUIRING AN EVALUATION OF OUTREACH ACTIVITIES  
FOR THE HUSKY PLAN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 319v of the general statutes be amended to require the  
2 Commissioner of Social Services to conduct a comprehensive, objective  
3 evaluation of all outreach activities for the HUSKY Plan that shall  
4 focus on new enrollments to the program rather than retention of  
5 clients, to provide that the evaluation shall be conducted by an  
6 independent, experienced evaluator with no financial interest in the  
7 program, and to provide that the Department of Social Services shall  
8 encourage funding entities of outreach activities other than the state to  
9 participate in the evaluation and include all eligible populations,  
10 including newly eligible parents.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To improve enrollment in the HUSKY Plan and reduce the number of uninsured Connecticut residents.
