**AN ACT CONCERNING THE LICENSING AND INSPECTION OF
SALONS AND DAY SPAS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 That chapters 386 and 387 of the general statutes be amended to
2 require all cosmetologist and barber establishments, including hair
3 salons, barber salons, nail salons, and day spas that include hair and
4 nails, to apply for salon licenses according to regulations of the
5 Department of Public health and to establish a license fee of one
6 hundred dollars that includes yearly salon inspections by the local
7 health department.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the licensing and inspection of salons and day spas.
