**AN ACT CONCERNING THE REPORTING OF TRAFFIC STOPS
STATISTICS BY POLICE DEPARTMENTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (h) of section 54-1m of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to extend the time for reporting traffic stop information from
- 3 January 1, 2002, to January 1, 2012.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that the Chief State's Attorney has enough data on traffic stops by police departments to provide the report to the General Assembly required by the Racial Profiling Act, public act 99-198.
