**AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEVELOPMENT OF A NATURE TRAIL,
CROSS-COUNTRY RUNNING COURSE AND ATHLETIC FIELDS IN
AVON.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 two hundred thousand dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used to
- 5 develop a nature trail, a cross-country running course and athletic
- 6 fields on property owned by the town of Avon.

Statement of Purpose:

To fund a nature trail, cross-country running course and athletic fields in Avon.
