**AN ACT PERMITTING MEDICAID REIMBURSEMENT FOR FEES
CHARGED BY PHARMACISTS FOR COGNITIVE SERVICES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 (NEW) The Commissioner of Social Services shall seek a waiver
- 2 from federal law to permit reimbursement under the Medicaid
- 3 program for fees charged by pharmacists licensed pursuant to chapter
- 4 400j of the general statutes for cognitive services.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase the quality of disease management for persons with a chronic disease through the cognitive services of licensed pharmacists.
