AN ACT REINSTATING MEDICAID FUNDING FOR DUALY-ELIGIBLE PATIENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (b) of section 17b-265 of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to eliminate the provision that requires the Commissioner of
- 3 Social Services to limit reimbursement to medical assistance providers
- 4 for coinsurance and deductible payments under the Social Security Act
- 5 to assure that the combined Medicare and Medicaid payment to the
- 6 provider does not exceed the maximum under the Medicaid program
- 7 fee schedules.

Statement of Purpose:

To eliminate the provision that requires the Commissioner of Social Services to limit reimbursement to medical assistance providers for coinsurance and deductible payments under the Social Security Act to assure that the combined Medicare and Medicaid payment to the provider does not exceed the maximum under the Medicaid program fee schedules.
