AN ACT CONCERNING FIREWORKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Subsection (a) of section 29-357 of the general statutes is repealed
2 and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

3 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, no person,
4 firm or corporation shall offer for sale, expose for sale, sell at retail or
5 use or explode or possess with intent to sell, use or explode any
6 fireworks. [, except, notwithstanding the provisions of section 29-356,
7 any person who is sixteen years of age or older may offer for sale,
8 expose for sale, sell at retail, purchase, use or possess with intent to sell
9 or use sparklers of not more than one hundred grams of pyrotechnic
10 mixture per item, which are nonexplosive and nonaerial.]

Statement of Purpose:

To make all fireworks, including sparklers, illegal in this state.
