AN ACT CONCERNING THE PENALTY FOR FALSE STATEMENTS ON APPLICATIONS FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM QUASI-PUBLIC AGENCIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 (NEW) Any person who intentionally makes any false statement or
2 misrepresentation in any application, agreement, financial statement,
3 certificate or other writing furnished to a quasi-public agency, as
4 defined in section 1-120 of the general statutes, and such person knows
5 the false statement or misrepresentation will be relied upon by such
6 quasi-public agency in connection with any loan, mortgage, guarantee,
7 investment, grant, lease, tax relief, bond financing or other extension of
8 credit or financial assistance made or provided by the quasi-public
9 agency, shall be fined not more than two thousand dollars or
10 imprisoned not more than one year or both.
